

ON orders by the HQ, CARPA has investigated the implementation of Blood Bracelets to use craft to boost morale amongst allied troops. The tactical endeavour has challenged the insurrectional use of "friendship bracelets" amongst pacifists and hippies to instead form a blood bond between soldiers to tighten moral and willingness of personal sacrifice for the values of the free west. As mentioned by Admiral [REDACTED] in report 2009:38.679.B, blood bracelet is a crafted gifts of attachment and ceremonial tokens exchanged in compassion, usually between elite soldiers or various nations, but also between mercenaries as a symbol of common sacrifice and comradeship. CARPA has introduced Blood Bracelets kits among stationed troops in forward observation bases [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to big success.

The Blood Bracelets kits serviced by CARPA support a handmade version, of parachute thread, grey embroidery floss or camouflage thread. CARPA has also introduced various styles and patterns inspired by our patriotic weapons, that all can be fabricated based on the same simple half-hitch knot. Amongst the Navy Seals we have supported a version of macrame as their training in textiles is more extensive through our all encompassing TEXsupp-program, running since 2007.
